CONCLUSIONS OF CONFERENCE

- Young people from Lendava know the cultural heritage of their town.
- Lendava is rich in cultural aspects: we have Slovenian, Hungarian, Roma and Jewish culture.
- Members of Club of Students presented mind mapping, which we made during local meetings – the point was on the cultural heritage is important for youth in Lendava. Then the students of Bilingual Primary School Lendava and students of Bilingual Secondary School Lendava presented the Slovenian and Hungarian cultural heritage in Lendava, Mr. Sandi Horvat presented Roma cultural heritage of Lendava and Mr. Dejan Suč presented Jewish cultural heritage of Lendava. Conclusion: In Lendava youth are familiar with cultural heritage of all culture, which are (or were) living in Lendava.
- The youth knows, that the cultural heritage is not only buildings, so they know, that cultural heritage includes tangible and intangible elements, because they presented buildings, people, food etc.







PARTNER TOWNS

- All the partners in the project presented the cultural heritage of their towns, each of them had 10 minutes.
- Youth from Lendava learned about the cultural heritage of Veszprem, Saint-Omer, Tartu and Eisenstadt.
- During the presentations they had possibilities to compare the cultural heritage of the towns involved in project.
- During the conference all the youth recognized the importance of the regulation of minority rights at national level.
